HSE MINIMUM ESSENTIAL TRAINING COURSES

To work as a home carer in Ireland, the HSE (Health Services Executive) insists all carers must take these 4 courses, as a minimum:



1. People Handling

- 1 day course
- Cost: €80.00

Nobody can start work as a carer without this course.



2. QQI "Care of the Older Person"

- 8 class course
- Cost: €195.00



3. QQI "Care Skills"

- 8 class course
- Cost: €195.00



4. Children First

You can take this self-learning online course free on the HSE website. Estimated time one hour.

- **Duration:** HSE Self taught online = 1 hour
Private HomeCare Taught Online Class = 3 hours
- **Learning Method:** Online
- **Cost:** HSE = free
Private HomeCare = €30.00

Note this course is mandatory even if you do not and never will care for children.

All courses are delivered by our inhouse training department. To support our carers we operate a "Learn as You Earn" flexible payment programme (terms and conditions apply), where the cost of your training can be deducted from your pay, over time.
